PRIVACY POLICY

We do not request or collect any information that is regarded as sensitive under data protection law.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation 2018 (GDPR), our lawful basis for collecting information from you either through the website, by email, telephone or other communication arises from the following legitimate interests which have been identified as a result of a legitimate interest assessment we have conducted. No telephone calls are recorded.

- To provide information concerning new products

- To meet our contractual commitments to you
- To fulfil responsibilities as an employer

We would only disclose personal information provided to us if legally required to do so or to assist fraud prevention and minimize credit risk. We do not share any information with third parties.

Your personal information may be stored either on our secure servers in the UK or on the servers of our associated companies throughout the world. Where these servers are outside the European Economic Area, the owner's data handling will meet the requirements of GDPR.

We have procedures and security features to protect your information. All digitally held information is password protected and accessed by limited named users.
